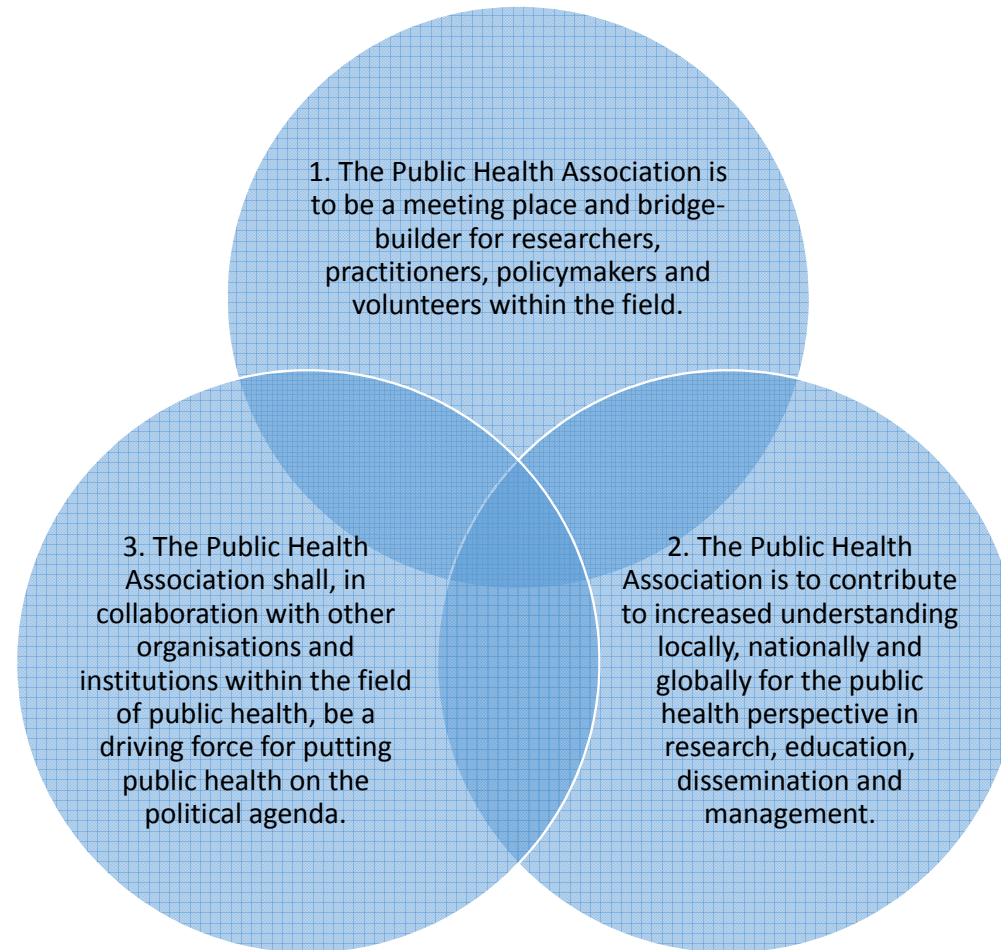
Introduction

- The Norwegian Public Health Association (NOPHA) is a member of the European Public Health Association (EUPHA) and the World Federation of Public Health Associations (WFPHA).
- The Association is open to people, organisations, companies and institutions that are interested in research and development within health promotion, prevention, treatment and rehabilitation (NOPHA's statutes § 3).

VISION

- The Norwegian Public Health Association shall contribute to improving people's health, environment and quality of life – locally, nationally and globally. The Association will engage in social development which promotes public health by, amongst other things, focussing attention on social inequalities in health, the population's health and wellbeing, good social and environmental conditions and the prevention of mental and somatic illness, injury and disease.
